IMPAX Application Administration



Course Overview:

The IMPAX Application Administration Training Course (previously named IMPAX 6 System Administration Class) is a beginner course intended specifically for new user training and designed to provide a comprehensive clinical overview of the IMPAX PACS solution. The course focuses on the complexity of the IMPAX Application and includes lecture, discussion, demonstration, hands-on training and post-course testing. The course is interactive and begins with a discussion of the responsibilities of the PACS System Administrator, a lecture on the IMPAX system and Radiology workflow follows in which discussion of "real world" experience is encouraged. The student is then taken through the use and basic customization of the IMPAX Application. Upon completion of the course, the PACS System Administrator will possess the ability to address application related end user questions/problems, provide daily system maintenance (security, study, and process related) and perform basic system troubleshooting. The trainee will have the opportunity to have all specific questions answered for a powerful and effective learning experience.

Target Audience:

PACS System Administrators, Radiology IT Administrators, Professional Services personnel, Technical Services personnel. This course is offered to all Agfa HealthCare customers, commercial and government.

Reviewing log files for troubleshooting assistance is included. Hands on service investigation and troubleshooting skills for IMPAX are emphasized. The trainee will have the opportunity to have all specific questions answered for a powerful and effective learning experience.
