Altamira Primer GP

Overview

The Altamira range of high-performance inks is targeting multiple applications that require superior adhesion on a broad range of substrates, including decorative printing, direct-to-shape printing, and marking & coding.

Altamira Primer GP is a digital primer solution to promote adhesion to the most difficult substrates and offers a complete digital solution when printing in combination with the image.

It will also help in controlling the wetting of the colors on top of the primer resulting in high-quality prints.

Key benefits

- Altamira Primer GP is a digital solution in case the adhesion needs to
 be further optimized. Traditional solutions to improve adhesion, such
 as pre-treatment (corona, plasma, flame) or the use of analog primer,
 are considered more complicated (additional process step, difficult to
 set right conditions). A digital primer is applied only where necessary
 and applied in-line with the printed image.
- Excellent adhesion on a broad range of substrates, glass and metals included, and improving the adhesion of Agfa's Altamira/Arigi inks on top of the primer resulting in optimal adhesion of the colored inks on top of these substrates
- Extremely high jetting performance and reliability

Field of use

Altamira Primer GP is suitable for printing with piezo print heads that require standard inkjet viscosity, including print heads from Konica Minolta, Ricoh, Toshiba TEC, Fujifilm Dimatix, Xaar and Seiko.

Functional specifications

- Suitable for printing single-pass or multi-pass; to print as undercoat layer before printing the image
- Good cure speed for curing with Hg bulbs & UV LED
- Printing on a broad range materials: PMMA, PC, PS, glass, metals (aluminium, steel, stainless steel...), ceramics, etc.
- Parameters suited for jetting with industrial piezo print heads needing standards viscosity range (8-14 mPa.s at jetting temperature)
